CHAPTER 15

Overcoming Fear & Finishing Strong

ONE DEMON SPIRIT WE ALL MUST OVERCOME

"For God has not given us the Spirit of fear, but of power, and of love and of a sound mind" (2 Timothy 1:7 KJVER).

⁷ "He that overcomes shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be My son (child). ⁹ **But the fearful, and unbelieving,** and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone: which is the second death" (Revelation 21:7-8 KJVER).

Everyone of us as Believers have our own personal demons that we must overcome. Whether it be lying, lusting, anger, pride, greed, selfishness, self will (stubbornness), drunkenness, etc. etc. However, there is one demonic spirit that is a common foe to us all and it must be overcome. The late Dr. Morris Cerullo has stated that "80 percent of the Christian Church is bound by fear" and its effects are devastating. The spirit of fear (which is often yoked with unbelief) is one of, if not the most powerful weapon in Satan's arsenal to control and manipulate the people of God. He uses it to cause us to draw back in fear from doing the Father's will and to default into doing his will. If we allow it, he will use fear to usurp and destroy our divine destiny in Christ. Even more horrifying is that he will use it to destroy our eternal soul in the torment of the lake of fire as revealed above. Consequently, it is imperative that we face down every fear and stronghold of unbelief and overcome them by the power of His grace, His Word, and His love. The following is a list of some of the fears that satanic powers are using in our lives to control us and prevent us from doing God's will:

- Fear of failure
- Fear of lack (not having enough)
- Fear of sickness and disease
- Fear of making mistakes
- Fear of death
- Fear of personal injury or harm
- Fear of speaking and sharing Jesus

- Fear of rejection
- Fear of abandonment
- Fear of inadequacy
- Fear of the unknown
- Fear of looking foolish ... etc.

The good news is that the Lord has given us the unlimited power of His spiritual weapons to overcome every fear. He has given us:

- 1) The power of His covenant grace purchased at the Cross
- 2) The power of His Holy Spirit that indwells us which includes His love
- 3) The power of His Word of truth to declare and defeat every demonic attack

God's grace is the unlimited power of God to overcome our fleshly tendencies to yield to fear or any other temptation. It is given to us so that we can rise up in the power of Holy Spirit and to boldly declare God's Word to defeat all satanic powers including fear. Jesus is our perfect example in this regard when He faced the direct temptation by Satan himself recorded in Matthew chapter 4 verses 1 to 11. Jesus' response to every attempt by Satan to pressure him to make a decision contrary to the Father's will was; "It is written ..." Jesus declared the Word of God in every instance and was able to overcome the temptation and defeat Satan's attack. In the same way we are given the same supernatural weapons to overcome every satanic temptation whether it be related to fear or otherwise. In fact, God's Word has promised us that we will never be tempted beyond our ability to overcome. That God will always provide a way of escape and victory:

¹³ "No temptation has taken you except what is common to man. God is faithful, and He will not permit you to be tempted above what you can endure, but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that you may be able to bear it" (I Corinthians 10:13 MEV).

¹⁴ "Now thanks be to God who always causes us to triumph in Christ and through us reveals the fragrance of His knowledge in every place" (2 Corinthians 2:14 MEV).

PUTTING ON THE ARMOUR OF GOD TO DEFEAT SATANIC POWERS

It is vitally important that we know the truth, His promises and His provision for victory otherwise satanic powers can deceive and cause us to stumble. That is why Jesus directed His people to abide in His Word (i.e., to study, know, obey, declare and share it; John 8:31-32). If you are not strong in the knowledge and application of God's Word you can be victimized by evil powers. Part of our battle each day is with fallen angelic powers or demons. The Word of God reveals that we must be clothed in "the whole armour of God" in order to prevail and defeat these evil "principalities" and "powers."

¹¹ "Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. ¹² For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities,

against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. ¹³ Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; ¹⁵ And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ¹⁶ Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. ¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: ¹⁸ Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints" (Ephesians 6:11-18 KJV).

The above passage reveals the critical importance of putting on this spiritual armour, but "How do we do this?" In putting on this armour we believe there is an element of declarative faith involved, but there is also a huge element of practical Holy Spirit led action and effort as well. Let's look at each piece of this armour and then see what the Holy Spirit has revealed regarding what is practically involved in putting it on:

When by the grace of God, we diligently implement these practical disciplines led by the Holy Spirit we will be strong in the LORD and in the power of His Word to defeat fear and every device of the enemy. Beloved you are called to be an overcomer in Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit working with the Word as His weapon of mass destruction to the powers of darkness. Every day we need to humbly wait upon Him in worship and His Word asking Him for a fresh infilling of His Holy Spirit to do His will in victory. When we do this, we will also experience the flow of His love being "shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Spirit" (Romans 5:5). It is God's perfect love from His Spirit that has power to dispel the effects of fear in our hearts "There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear: because fear has torment. He that fears is not made perfect in love" (I John 4:18 KJVER).

Thank God for His provision of everything we need to be overcomers of fear and every evil spiritual power and temptation including the spirits of lust, perversion, anger or whatever. Dear one, overcoming is not an option. It is imperative and absolutely critical. God died a very cruel death to provide everything we need to overcome our flesh, the devil and this satanically controlled world system. Therefore, He requires us by His grace to do it. If we allow our sinful nature, satanic temptation or the lust for this world's pleasure to prevail we will perish. This is why Jesus made this very sober warning regarding the sin of lust:

²⁷ "You have heard that it was said by the ancients, 'You shall not commit adultery. ²⁸ But I say to you that whoever looks on a woman to lust after her has committed adultery with her already in his heart. ²⁹ And if your right eye causes you to sin, pluck it out and throw it away. For it is profitable that one of your members should perish, and not that your whole body be thrown into hell. ³⁰ And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away. For it is profitable for you that one of your members should perish, and not that your whole body be thrown into hell" (Matthew 5:27-30 MEV).

Jesus was not advocating that you literally dismember yourself in order to overcome your sinful passions and to avoid hell. However, in no uncertain terms He was warning us of our need to be absolutely ruthless and radical in our efforts to overcome lust and every sinful passion we struggle with. We must not let lust, fear, self will, pride or anything to control us and cause us to disobey our Father's will

and thus sin (Matthew 7:21-23). He paid the ultimate price for us to be overcomers and we need to embrace His grace and ruthlessly enforce His victory over every sinful passion and demonic power. *In Jesus' Mighty Name, Amen!*

A WORLD RIFE WITH FEAR AND UNCERTAINTY

At the time of this writing COVID 19 is rising in an ugly second wave with the Media stoking fears of rising death tolls worldwide. At the same time the U.S. election results have been brought into question due to massive legal action related to suspected illegal mail-in ballots being used to steal the election from President Democrat controlled swing states are attempting to block Republican Scrutineers from observing the remaining vote counts in what appears to be a cover up for this fraudulent activity. Pastor Hank shared that God had given him three words in light of the current situation; Decisive, Delay and Defraud. First of all, President Trump's ultimate election victory will be humbling and Decisive. Second, it will be Delayed in order to investigate and expose fraudulent activity in the election and to keep Pres. Trump humbly reliant upon the Lord both now and in the days moving ahead. What I have often told our youth I declare again; "I'm not going to die, but by God's grace I'm' going to fly out of here in Jesus' Mighty Name. Amen!"
